Life-saving Ventilators

In 2020, SCHN used the funds donated by Sell & Parker to purchase 22 life-saving ventilators for the Intensive Care Unit at Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick.

The Hospital team has ensured several replaced ventilators, previously donated by Sell & Parker, have been kept at the Hospital in preparation for emergency COVID-19 requirements. Past replaced ventilators were also gifted to regional hospitals, as well as veterinary hospitals during the 2020 bushfires to help care for animals from fire-related injuries.

Your generous contributions ensures we have the most up to date equipment, allowing us to provide the sickest children in NSW with the best possible car, particularly during trying times, such as the COVID pandemic.









The Intensive Care Unit – Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick

In 2021, newborn baby 'C' arrived in the ICU with gastroschisis, a condition where an opening forms in the baby's abdominal wall in utero, causing the bowel to develop outside of the body in the amniotic fluid.

Gastroschisis requires urgent, lifesaving surgery soon after birth, and the ICU team was ready to receive and stabilise baby C.

2 weeks after arriving in the ICU baby C underwent surgery to have the bowel inserted into their tiny body. Baby C has since made a full recovery!

C's time in the ICU was supported directly by items funded by Sell & Parker, including the ventilator, ultrasound machine, portable trolley, and even the bed baby C stayed in.

Your incredible donations contributed to a terrific health outcome for baby C, and C is just one of many sick and injured children who have benefited directly from your generous support – thank you!
